FNU determines full-time study as 5 or more credits in a term. Each academic term is 11 weeks.

Students should anticipate their academic workload to be as follows:

- 1-2 credits = at least 5-11 study hours a week
- 3-6 credits = at least 14-33 study hours a week
- 7-10 credits = at least 32-55 hours a week

Students may petition the university to take a one term academic hiatus (AH) or emergency academic hiatus (EAH); but are limited to a total of two academic hiatus terms every 365 days.
